“The Global Engagement Funds enabled us to bring some brilliant Thai artists to the UK for a fourth edition of Monologue/Dialogue, an exhibition series alternating between Thailand and the UK that I have organised and participated in since 2006.

Founded in partnership with the British Council, the exhibition celebrates transcultural conversations by bringing together artists from across the world and installing or constructing work together. This develops existing contacts between UK and Thai universities and the Thai, British and international art discourses.

This edition, *MD4: Mysticism and Insecurity* took place at London’s Koppel Gallery in Baker Street with 16 artists mainly from Thailand and the UK, but also from Singapore, Bangladesh, China and Japan.

Dr Kai Syng Tan and I organised numerous events in the gallery, including exhibition tours and discussions engaging the public, students and artists. We received additional funding from the Thai Embassy and the Thai Ambassador opened the exhibition.”
