Why is so there much personal & institutional anger, denial, and resistance about points 1 and 2?





By **2030**: at least **2 million people 65** and over **Ageing Without Children.**

At least **24**% of **men are childless.**



Male childlessness/infertility excluded from masculinities literature.



Childless men have higher death rate through suicide than fathers.



Childless men are less wealthy and less happy than fathers



Older men are more likely to be placed in formal care than equivalent women Older me

Older men fear being seen a paedosexual
